**Concerts** – Carol, Christina – Agreed at last meeting that Almost Acoustic would no longer be a Folk Federation activity. Christina & Carol reported on the program planned for the next 6 months at Eastside & tabled the new Eastside promotional CD. Eastside is trying to present a balance of well known & new artists. Ideas. inspiration, assistance sought.

Chris noted that there appears to be a perception around Australia that international folk artists bypass Sydney because of the difficulty of getting gigs. Our mission should be to turn that perception around.

- Headline artist + new artists

- 3 events during Folk Week Emerging Artists, Folk Clubs, Showcase Event

Subcommittee formed to discuss development of NSW Folk Week in July – Pam M, Jennifer, Carol, Christina, Kate

Radio - Chris advised Danny Watson former Pres of FF has started a radio program in Narrabri area. All Committee members encouraged to send CDs to Danny at TRALEE, Maules Creek via Boggabri NSW 2382. Chris also advised that Bruce is intending to produce 6 programs by the end of the year, to be available for use by any folk radio presenter.

- **Magazine** Mary-Jane has edited & amended the choir list in Cornstalk. Chris suggested running Folk Club ads in Cornstalk without cost; this idea was rejected by the committee.

 NSW Folk Library – repository for print music, books, cds, records etc. Chris Wheeler has spoken to NSW Mechanics Institute about hosting our folk collection, ideally in a room dedicated to this purpose. They have library space, funding, a librarian, a stage, space for workshops etc – a potential city "home" for the FF. FF will seek \$3k establishment costs plus \$2k annually to fund project. Advice needed from Committee re likely volume of material.

Committee enthusiastically endorsed the concept. Chris & Mary-Jane to investigate further.

• Chris has made contact with Carriageworks (new performance space in Wilson St, Redfern) with a view to establishing a partnership relationship.
